2. The Executive Summary must include the following: a) Introduction/ Rationale; b) Objectives of the Study; c) Research Questions; d) Sampling and Methodology; e) Results and Findings; f)Conclusions and Recommendations
3. Include the following additional information relative to your submission: a) name; b) position/ profession; c) office; d) contact numbers and address; e) year study started and completed; f) Key messages or keywords
3. The Selection Committee will review and approve your submission no later than October 15, 2012
4. Deadline for submission of research or paper entries is until October 5, 2012.
