Philippine Health Research Registry (PHRR)

PHRR is a tool for good governance to promote transparency and accountability in health research. It is a publicly accessible database on newly approved health researches that includes clinical trials and non-clinical studies conducted in the country.

RESEARCH UTILIZATION

Support to Research Dissemination

The Research Information, Communication, and Utilization Division of PCHRD supports projects and activities on research dissemination, including, but not limited to support to publication, paper presentation, and events.

Publication Support

Researches, either funded or not by the Council, which are accepted for publication in local or international peer-reviewed journals may request for publication support.

PCHRD also gives financial assistance to Filipino researchers who would like to print their monographs or books which are in line with the National Unified Health Research Agenda (NUHRA).

Technology Transfer and Commercialization

The Council facilitates the identification and packaging of PCHRD-supported health technologies for adoption and commercialization by both government and private sectors and guides researchers and investors as they go through each step of idea generation to utilization.

Research Translation - Policy

PCHRD provides financial support for policy note brief development and help proponents find research experts to assist them in drafting their policy note/brief.

To avail support to research dissemination, publication support, and policy translation, interested parties are required to submit a letter addressed to PCHRD Executive Director and line-item budget.
